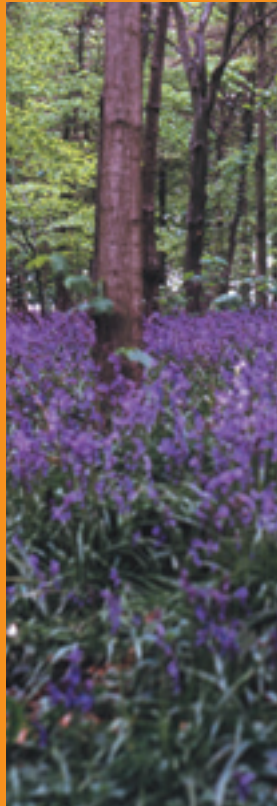


Your **Legacy** counts
